SUBJECT: PORTABLE TORQUE GUIDES

104-116, 121, 125, 128, 132, 134, 140

DISCUSSION: When running casing, angles on the Torque Guide Section 2 can be a snag

hazard if using a pick-up/lay down machine to push the casing.

RECOMMENDATION: The angles can be trimmed back approximately ½ inch to be flush or

recessed with the bottom of the Torque Guide tube. See attached drawing. The angle should be beveled and ground smooth. This will help prevent

premature wear of the Top Drive guide rails.




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EXISTING SECTION 2
