BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Tesco has identified that the torsion spring (Item 12 Drawing 610091) may fail to maintain sufficient force to hold the safety latch closed, in the event of hydraulic failure to the single joint casing elevator. This spring is used to maintain the safety latch in the closed (locked) position in the event the elevator's hydraulic circuit looses complete pressure.

A new more robust replacement spring has been identified and is available.
