BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

A dropped object incident was reported in August 2016 which involved falling debris from the blower motor's metal cover on an ESI Top Drive electric motor assembly. This resulted from the disintegration of the metal cover due to long-term wear on the blower motor. This was an isolated incident with no reported injuries to rig personnel. Tesco is currently conducting an investigation to ensure that secondary retention for the blower motor meets or exceeds DROPS recommendations as per Tesco's Dropped Object Prevention Program. Further information will be provided in a later revision of this bulletin after a thorough investigation has been conducted with our customer's QHSE team.




Figure 1: Motor cover

ACTION REQUIRED:

For ESI Top Drives currently operating in the field, Tesco recommends the following:

- 1. Ensure that secondary retention is applied for the blower motor.
 - Refer to Tesco drawing no. 7000060 to ensure that a sling wire rope (5036166) and a shackle (4770) are used to secure the blower motor to the electric motor assembly.




Figure 2: Secondary retention for blower motor

2. The secondary retention mentioned in Step 1 above does NOT contain the blower motor's metal cover if it disintegrates. As such, Tesco recommends visual inspection of the metal cover for cracks, damage, or any other signs of deterioration. If any signs of deterioration are identified, remove the metal cover and fasteners, and then contact a local Tesco representative immediately.
