Grabber Clamping Box Inspection

Issue

Canrig was made aware of an incident wherein the grabber die holder plate separated from the grabber clamping box after the grabber was forced away from the grabber leg whilst torquing. Canrig recommends inspection as a precaution to prevent a dropped object incident.

Recommendation

Canrig recommends inspecting the grabber clamping box including welds and replace the part if cracks or signs of damages are present.




Figure 2: Grabber clamping box

Inspection

1. Visually check the entire grabber clamping box including the inside corners of the grabber die plate for cracks or other signs of damage.




Figure 3: Grabber die plate inside corners
